STUDENT RECITAL SCHEDULING POLICY

All recitals must be held before reading day in the fall or spring semester.

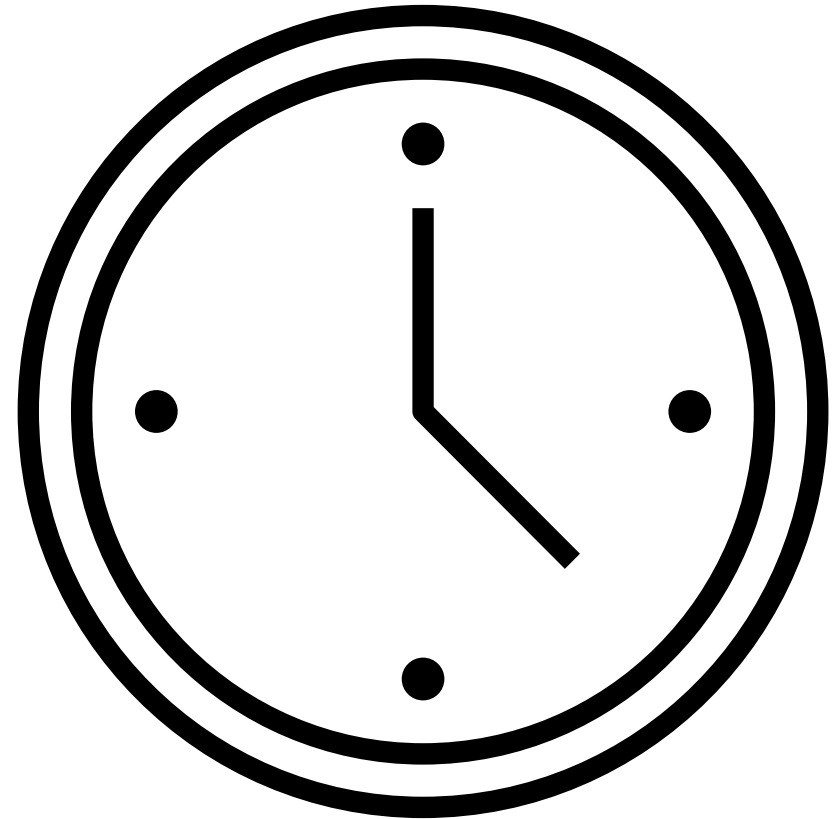
Recitals are not to be held during final exams, reading day, winter break, or during the summer.

Degree recitals should be held in an approved School of Music performance venue.

- Exceptions are rare and must be approved through an Exception to Policy prior to scheduling or performing the recital.
- The student is responsible for providing the School of Music with a high-quality recording of any off-campus degree recitals.

STANDARDIZED RECITAL START TIMES

- Monday – Friday
 - 4pm, 6pm or 8pm
- Saturday and Sunday
 - 10am, 12pm, 2pm, 4pm, 6pm or 8pm



RECITAL DETAILS

Each recital will have a 30-minute warm-up before the scheduled recital start time.

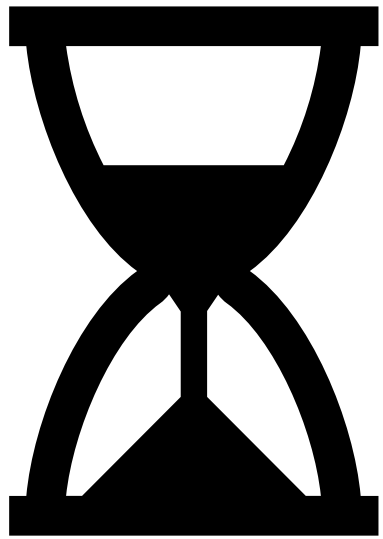


After each recital, an additional 30-minutes is given for reception and cleanup.

- Student UCard will be programmed for access on recital day.





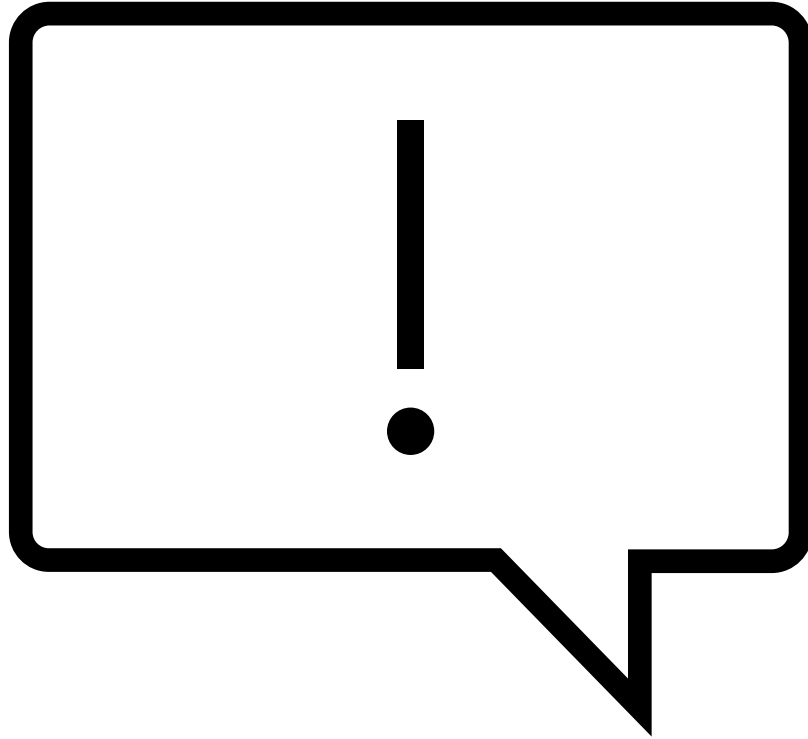

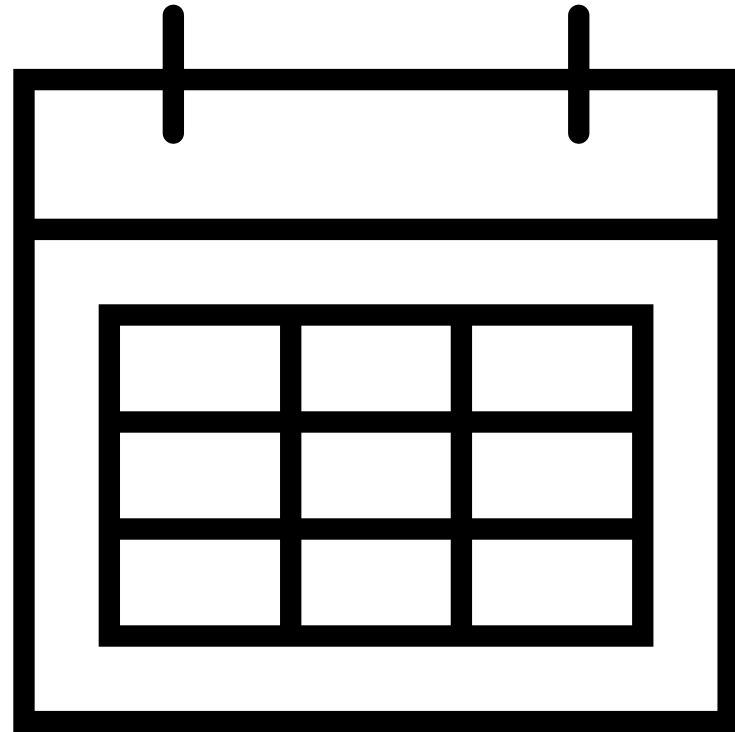


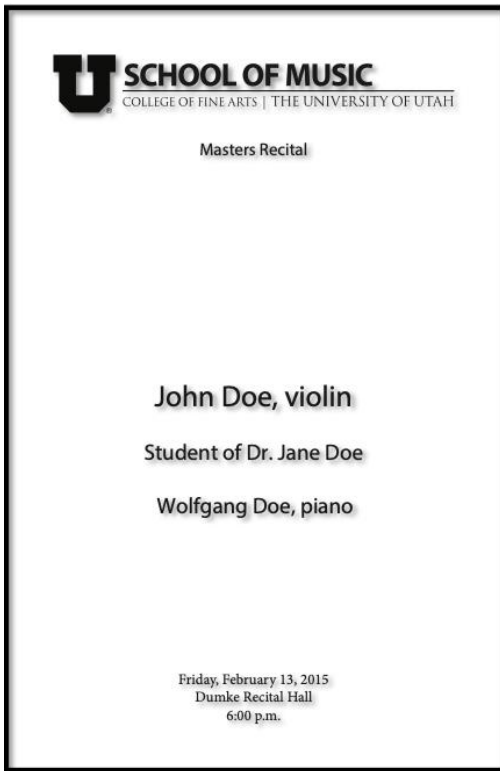
Recital Scheduling Request

- Please select and submit your recital scheduling request using the provided link.
- A refundable \$25 deposit is required for all student recitals.

FINALIZING RECITAL DATE

- Once you have paid your recital deposit or fee, you will be emailed a link during the first week of the semester to finalize your recital date and time.
 - Please confirm this time with your private teacher or supervisory committee before scheduling your recital.

Recital Dress Rehearsal

- Once you receive an email from facilities@music.utah.edu confirming your recital date and time, you may submit your desired dress rehearsal time
 - Each recital is entitled to a one-hour dress rehearsal
 - Dress rehearsals must be Monday – Friday 8am-2:30pm

Recital Preview

(Only required for Master students)

- Recital preview requests may be submitted at the same time as dress rehearsal request
 - Recital previews may be completed in instructor's lesson space
 - If the performance venue is needed for preview, it must be Monday – Friday 8am - 2:30pm
