Musicology Electives and Seminars:

- Musicology Elective Courses: MUSC 46XX/66XX and 4870/6890
 - 1-2 of these are always available each semester, Fall and Spring
 - Informal rotation that prioritizes the more popular offerings
 - Fall rotation: Classical, 19th century topics
 - Spring rotation: Renaissance, Baroque, 20th/21st century, Musical theatre
- Graduate Seminars: MUSC 6800–04, 6890 and 7800–04 and 7890
 - 1-2 of these are always available each semester, Fall and Spring
 - Focused seminar-style courses that explore music through a particular issue or concept
 - Recent Fall topics: Mahler, Music and National Identity
 - Recent Spring topics: Performing Race on Broadway, Women in Early Music
