International Piano Festival, and 1st place in the Charleston International Music Competition, among others. Aside from music, Olivia also enjoys math, tennis, and chess.



Joyce Wang has been studying piano since the age of three. She has competed and placed in many piano events such as the Salt Lake Piano Competition (1st), Pacific Stars International Piano Competition(1st), Weber State Piano Festival (1st), SummerArts Piano Competition (1st), MTNA National Finalist (Duet Division), and Princeton Piano Festival (1st in Duet Division). In addition, she has previously played

with the Salt Lake Symphony. Joyce shares her love of music to the community by playing the piano during worship at church as well as volunteering at local senior homes. As of now, Joyce is a freshman studying Business and Social Policy at Rice University.



Jingyu Guo began pursuing a Doctor of Musical Arts (DMA) in Piano Performance at the University of Utah School of Music in 2023 under the mentorship of Dr. Ning Lu. In 2020, he performed the Yellow River Piano Concerto with the NENU Youth Symphony Orchestra in China and has since been an active participant in the field of chamber music. He has successfully presented several themed recitals in both China and the United States.



Jenny Song, a native of China, is a versatile solo and collaborative pianist. As a soloist, she has performed solo recitals in China and many places in the United States, such as Michigan, Miami, and Kansas. Besides solo performance, Jenny is an active collaborative pianist and holds a strong interest in contemporary music. She has played in contemporary ensemble groups, recently highlighting works by Chinese Women composer Chen Yi, Ravel Reimagined piano work, and Messiaen's Visions de l'Amen.

Jenny received a Master of Music degree in Piano Performance from Michigan State University, where she studied under Margarita Shevchenko. She is currently pursuing a Doctor of Musical Arts degree at the University of Utah under the guidance of Professor Ning Lu.



Hao Ding is a pianist currently pursuing a Doctor of Musical Arts (DMA) degree in piano performance at the University of Utah. Hao earned his Master of Music (MM) degree from the Longy School of Music of Bard College, where he gave numerous solo recitals and frequently served as an accompanist. His performances, praised for their adaptability and artistry, highlight his skill and dedication to collaborative playing.

In 2024, Hao was awarded the Young Artist Solo First Prize and Young Artist Concerto First Prize at the SummerArts Piano Competition, affirming his technical brilliance and musical artistry. He draws inspiration from underrepresented composers such as Arne Oldberg, Adolf von Henselt, and Mélanie Bonis, and he is passionate about introducing their works to broader audiences.

In addition to pursuing new heights in piano performance, Hao is committed to sharing the beauty of music with others and inspiring the next generation of musicians. He teaches piano at Washington Elementary School and volunteers at the Huntsman Cancer Hospital, using music to nurture young talent and bring comfort to patients.
